



# SERENDIPITY ECO TRAIL

- Venue: Serendipity Eco Trails, Modimolle
- Cost: R1 200 per vehicle (2 people in vehicle)  
R300 per additional passenger

## Tour Details

Serendipity Eco Trails is situated on a private game farm Tierkloof, in the district of Mookgopong (Naboomspruit), Limpopo Province, 140 km from Pretoria.

The trails stretch over an unusual combination of valleys, gorges, savannah and mountain streams. Rock pools with crystal clear water, indigenous forest, waterfalls, and panoramic views of the Waterberg await you. A large variety of trees, abundant bird life and game can be seen and enjoyed while slowly taking on the challenge of this trail.

We will meet at our campsite on Friday afternoon and enjoy a social braai together that night. On Saturday morning we will tackle the 3-hour trail, stopping frequently to enjoy the rock pools and many sights along the way. We will stop for lunch in the bush before completing the trail and arriving back at camp in the afternoon.

On Sunday you have the option of driving the more technical and challenging 1-hour trail or you can just relax in the campsite enjoying the tranquillity of your surroundings before packing up camp and heading home.

Group size is limited to 14 vehicles so book early to secure your spot.

VHF Radios are compulsory for this trip. Radios can be hired at R30 per day should you not have your own radio.
